

# Divisional Shootout for the Nelson Ledges Cup

## Rules

### 1. Teams

A. Teams of equal size representing Great Lakes Division and Northeast Division will be set .

B. Team membership will be determined by the region listed on an entrants entry form for the event.

### 2. Judges

A. The Race Chairperson or a designee of the Race Chairperson shall act as a judge in case of any disputes over these rules.

### 3. Points

A. Cars scoring points in each race group will be determined by the number of entrants for that race group from the Team with the smaller car count in that race group.

B. Which cars will be scoring points for the Team with the higher car count in that race group will be chosen based upon that days qualifying session or qualifying race, which ever is the closest to the actual race session that day.

C. Cars from the Team with the higher count in that race group which were not selected will not score any points that day. These cars may still aid their Team by acting as spoilers finishing ahead of cars from the other team and depriving them of some points.

D. Points will be awarded based on provisional race results. Adjustments to provisional results will be handled as addressed in 3-E.

E. Any car losing positions in the final race results on Saturday as the result of a Stewards Action will be stripped of all points and thats teams running points total will be adjusted before the start of Sunday competition. If the Stewards Action and resulting loss of position happens on Sunday the Event points will stand but that Team will be assessed an equal negative points penalty at the start of the following years Event.

F. Cars scored as Did Not Start (DNS) or Did Not Finish (DNF) in their race group will be scored zero (0) points. Cars not being selected in the qualifying sessions will not be moved up into a scoring role as a replacement.

G. Cars from each race group will be scored points based on their finishing positions. The total points scored by the teams over both days of the Event will determine the winning Team.

H. Shootout points are separate from Kryderacing points. All entrants will be scored Kryderacing points according to that series rules.

### 4. Captains

A. Each team will be represented a Captain. The Captains will speak for their respective teams during the event.

B. It is the Captain of the winning team to which the trophy will be presented at the end of the event. The first Captains will be appointed by Mahoning Valley Region SCCA, the organizing Region. A Captain wishing to step down will be given the chance of picking a successor. If no replacement is picked by the departing Captain Mahoning Vally Region will pick one.

C. Each Captain will be given a copy of these rules and the accompanying Intent list

D. During the off season the Captains will work with Mahoning Valley Region with input to help improve the Event for all involved

E. The Captains will present all questions or points disputes to the Judge.

### 5. Ties

A. In the unlikely event of a tied score after two days of racing the following list of tie breakers will be used in the published order to the point where the tie is broken.

- a. Team with the most group wins.
- b. Team with the most group second place finishes.
- c. Team with the most group third place finishes.
- d. Team with the most group fourth place finishes.
- e. Team with the most group fifth place finishes.
- f. The Judge will toss a coin.

B. If the need for a coin toss arises the Captains will call the toss. Great Lakes Division Captain will call the toss in odd numbered years, the Northeast Division Captain will call the toss in even numbered years.

## 6. Team Identification

A. All cars will be provided with a team identification logo. This will double as the tech sticker for the event.

B. Team identification logos are to be displayed on the left side of all cars next to their side number at a 2 o'clock position.

## 7. Trophy

A. The Nelson Ledges Cup will be presented to the winning team Captain. That Captain will be responsible for the trophy until the next Divisional Shootout for the Nelson Ledges Cup at which time it will be held for awarding the next winner.

## 8. Points Keeper

A. The hosting region will supply an official points keeper at the event that will not be part of the timing and scoring team.

B. The Captain of each team will arrange for representative points keeper for their team.

C. The two team representative points keepers will work with the official points keeper to verify the results after each session.
